

**NEVADA INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION
PRIVATE SCHOOL COMPLIANCE FORM**

As the principal of _____ High School, a member of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA), I agree to abide by the following:

- Conduct pre-season coaches meetings that will, among other things, review all NIAA issues as they refer to recruiting;
- Ensure there is adequate security for all athletic events as discussed and approved by each league;
- Ensure equivalent transportation for post-season competition is utilized as discussed and approved by each league;
- Abide by all decisions and rulings rendered by the NIAA, the Executive Director and / or a Level II hearing officer. Students ruled ineligible WILL NOT be allowed to participate for our school regardless of whether that student obtains a court order to the contrary (AB 391); per AB 391.
- Ensure all student-athletes are approved and cleared for eligibility by the Executive Director of the NIAA. Those not approved WILL NOT be eligible to participate in athletics at our school;
- Submit a copy of my school's enrollment procedures to the NIAA prior to the commencement of each school year;
- Inform my coaching staff they may only attend athletic events at our designated feeder school(s). Their attendance at public middle schools athletic events is strictly prohibited without prior approval and will be viewed as a form of illegal recruitment;
- Ensure all scholarships and student assistance funds are awarded from a general school fund and that no student-athlete's tuition is being paid by a sponsor or third party who is not a member of the student-athlete's family;
- Ensure all anonymous donations are approved and not used to fund tuition or other costs incurred by student-athletes.
- Ensure all athletes and parent(s) complete and sign a form that states they are aware that accepting tuition payment from someone other than a member of their family is against NIAA regulations. In addition, they understand that accepting such payment will result in a loss of athletic eligibility at the high school level and may result in a NCAA violation;
- Meet with league and public school principals / athletic administrators at the beginning of each school year; at the end of the winter season and at the end of the school year to establish and maintain positive communication with respect to all athletic issues.

I understand that failure to abide by the aforementioned guidelines may result in sanctions, probation, suspension or non-renewal of my school's membership in the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association in accordance with NIAA regulations.
