

2008 NIAA CLASS 4A SUNSET REGION BOYS GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RESULTS

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Invitations for participation in the 2008 NIAA 4A Sunset Region Boys Golf Championship tournament will be extended to those TEAMS that meet the qualifying standards – by either Southeast League / Northeast League regular-season (CCSD scheduled) tournament averages and/or tournament bests – established by the Southern Nevada High School Boys Golf Coaches Association. NOT MORE THAN A TOTAL OF EIGHT (8) TEAMS, REGARDLESS OF LEAGUE AFFILIATION / REPRESENTATION, WILL BE GRANTED ENTRY IN TO THIS YEAR’S REGION CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT.

1b. Invitations for participation in the 2008 NIAA 4A Sunset Region Boys Golf Championship tournament will be extended to those INDIVIDUALS FROM NON-QUALIFYING TEAMS that meet the qualifying standards – by either Southeast League / Northeast League regular-season (CCSD scheduled) tournament averages and/or tournament bests – established by the Southern Nevada High School Boys Golf Coaches Association. NOT MORE THAN A TOTAL OF TEN (10) INDIVIDUALS, REGARDLESS OF LEAGUE AFFILIATION / REPRESENTATION, WILL BE GRANTED ENTRY IN TO THIS YEAR’S REGION CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT.

2. State Qualifying: The top two (2) teams and the top five (5) individuals from non-qualifying teams from all three (Sunset, Sunrise and Northern) 4A region tournaments will advance to the 2008 NIAA Class 4A Nevada State High School Boys Golf Championship tournament, presented by the Las Vegas Review-Journal and Farmers Insurance Group. The state tournament is scheduled to be played May 12 & 13 at the TPC Las Vegas.

3. Teams will consist of a maximum of six (6) players, but teams must have a minimum of five (5) scorecards signed and turned in after the round to post a team score.

4. The 2008 NIAA 4A Sunset Region Championship tournament is scheduled for a one-day, 18-hole round. A team’s best five (5) scores will count to determine the total. Players must turn in a signed scorecard to qualify for individual honors.

5. The 2008 NIAA 4A Sunset Region Championship tournament will be governed by the USGA's "2008 Rules of Golf" book, the NIAA Handbook, the NIAA Reference Manual, this tournament information packet and the local rule sheet published specifically for this tournament. This tournament information packet serves as a binding document for the rules and regulations of the tournament.

6. Pairings and tee times will be determined by the Tournament Director (Larry Goins) and be based on regular-season performances.

Please note that starting times will be sent out via e-mail when they become available.

7. No substitutions will be allowed after the start of the tournament, even in the case of injury or illness.

Should an injury, disqualification, etc. occur, the individuals of a team will still be eligible to compete for individual honors. A team must, however, have five scores posted to compete for team honors.

8. Should weather, darkness, etc., not allow for the (final) completion of the round, final team and individual scores will be based on the results of the 9-hole totals, provided every player in the field has completed 9-holes.

In the event the round has to be postponed, it will be rescheduled for the next possible and available date. Efforts will be made to complete the round.

However, in the event the round cannot be rescheduled and/or completed, final team and individual scores will be based on the 9-hole totals.

In the event the round cannot be played (completed through 9-holes), the regular-season Southeast and Northeast league champions will advance to the state tournament as the region's two representatives / qualifiers.

NOTE: Every effort will be made to achieve a completion of the tournament.

The Tournament Director has the authority to make any necessary adjustments / changes to the tournament schedule, site, etc.

9. The individual golfer will be responsible for a competitor's scorecard as well as running a check of his own. Monitors will not make rulings. Monitors are to assist only in the capacity of pace of play and running a check of the scorecard(s). USGA officials / tournament officials / local golf course shop staff will be responsible for rulings. The Tournament Director will designate the ruling body.

10. No practice round has been scheduled. Any team or individual wishing to play the course at any time prior to the region tournament (the seven-day rule is not in effect) should make arrangements by calling the golf course.

11. A region tournament cannot be held on the same course as the state tournament.

12. The use of a motorized cart must be approved by the NIAA. Caddies and/or an assistant on the bag are not allowed except during a playoff. Pull carts are permitted.

13. No provisions have been made for the coaches to play the day of the championship. Coaches are asked to be present at the site of the tournament while play is in progress in case they are needed.

NEVADA COACHING REGULATION

NOTE: Spectators are allowed on the course but are NOT permitted to offer advice to a player during a round. Spectators must sign the release/waiver/rules acknowledgement form prior to entering the course.

Coaching will be permitted in the 4A region and state golf tournaments. Coaches must, however, adhere to the following criteria:

1. Coaching will be permitted between holes only (defined as after a specific competitor has holed out and/or before she has struck the ensuing tee shot).

2. The coach must be approved through his/her respective school, administration and/or district. The coach will be required to wear/display a nametag/badge identifying him/her as the approved on-course coach.

3. Only one (1) coach may coach during the event.

3b. In the spirit of the coaching rule, players are at no time to be coaches. Once a competitor has completed his round, he shall become a spectator (subject to the restrictions of a spectator and fellow competitor) and will thus not be permitted to offer advice to teammates still out on the course.

c. The penalty for offering advice to a teammate or any other competitor while play is in progress shall be two strokes per incident in accordance with the USGA's rule book as determined by the tournament director and verified by the tournament director and the tournament's rules committee.

4. It is imperative that coaches do not slow the pace of play. Slow play will be penalized per USGA rules.

5. No teaching aid, ***distance measuring device*** or other technology will be allowed on the course. This would include, but not be limited to, radios, cell phones, video cameras, etc.

6. If a coach violates any of these rules, he/she will be asked to immediately return and remain at the clubhouse. The school will then lose all coaching privileges for the remainder of the tournament.

NIAA REGION TOURNAMENT TIE-BREAKER

I. Boys golf will follow the rules and regulations of the United States Golf Association, NIAA Handbook, NIAA Reference Manual and this tournament information packet.

Ties involving teams during tournament play

A. The aggregate stroke score / total of the five (5) lowest 18-hole scores for each team shall constitute their school's team score. Ties for the championship and/or runner-up trophies will be handled in accordance with NIAA playoff procedures described below.

1. If the aggregate stroke score / total of the low five (5) scores posted for a team results in a tie, the lowest total score of the sixth person on the team will determine the winner. If one team does not have a sixth score total and the other team does, the team with the sixth score total wins.

If the aggregate stroke score / total of the sixth person also results in a tie, all six players from each team will play one hole of sudden victory.

In this playoff, each team will count its lowest five (5) scores on the hole with the lowest aggregate stroke score / total resulting in the winner. If the total of the low five (5) scores result in a tie, the lower (lowest) score of the sixth player on the sudden victory hole will determine the winner.

If the score of the sixth players also results in a tie, the teams will play another hole and thus proceed with the tie-breaking procedure as outlined here. This playoff procedure will continue until a winner is determined.

Ties involving individual medalists

A. Only ties for the (top) medalist (first place) will be broken by a sudden victory playoff. Other ties for medals will be determined by matching scorecards, as recommended by the USGA and outlined below:

1. The player with the best/lowest score on the back nine will earn the higher/better finishing place.
2. If a tie remains, the player with the best/lowest score on the final six holes will earn the higher/better finishing place.
3. If a tie remains, the player with the best/lowest score on the final three holes will earn the higher/better finishing place.
4. If a tie remains, the player with the best/lowest score on the 18th hole will earn the higher/better finishing place.

Note: In the event multiple tees are used to start the tournament, the last nine holes will be Nos. 10-18 on the scorecard, the last six will be Nos. 13-18 on the scorecard, etc. At all times, even in the event of a "split tees" and/or "shotgun" start, the last nine holes will be represented by Nos. 10-18 on the scorecard.
